Pennsylvania's infant mortality rate is higher than the United States infant mortality rate. Furthermore, mortality rates among certain ethnic minorities in Pennsylvania are significantly higher. The Bureau has identified areas within the Commonwealth where infant mortality rates are persistently high and are developing strategies to address the issue. The 2008 pregnancy rate for 15-19 year old Blacks was 123.5 compared to 26.4 for 15-19 year old Whites. Hispanic teens aged 15-19 had a pregnancy rate of 104.4 and Asian/Pacific Islander teens aged 15-19 had a pregnancy rate of 21.6 in 2008.
